

The e-motion M15 has been designed according to the guidelines of IATA (International Air Transport Association) to allow the transport of the wheels without batteries in the cargo area of aircrafts.

- 1. Both batteries of the e-motion M15 must be removed and the battery contacts need to be secured with the dedicated yellow protection covers.
- 2. The batteries may be transported separately in the cabin of the aircraft. Please inform the crew, where the batteries are stowed during the flight.
- 3. The lithium-ion batteries of the e-motion M25 (UN3481) were successfully tested according to the normative required procedure UN38.3.
- 4. The battery pack has a maximum of storable energy of 140,4 Wh and is therefore <u>below</u> the defined IATA limit of <u>160 Wh</u>.
- 5. We strongly recommend contacting the airline sufficiently in advance to request approval for transport of the e-motion.
